<u>Seaforth, Ontario</u>. Effective September 22, 2021 the Municipality of Huron East will be requiring Proof of Vaccination at all of its indoor recreational facilities. Patrons will be required to provide valid government identification <u>and</u> Proof of Vaccination in accordance with Ontario Regulation 645/21.

Under Ontario Regulation 645/21 each facility is required to obtain valid Proof of Vaccination from all patrons prior to admittance, save and except the following:

- Children under 12 years of age (Proof of Age may be requested and, if requested, must be provided to gain entry);
- Youth under 18 years of age <u>who are actively participating</u> in the organized sport or activity which is currently or immediately occurring at the facility; or
- Persons with Proof of Medical Reason for Not Being Vaccinated: Proof must be provided with government identification and must:
  - Name the person in the written documentation which matches the identification provided;
  - Provide name and contact information of the physician or registered nurse in the extended class;
  - Include a logo or letterhead identifying the physician or registered nurse in the extended class;
  - Include a statement that there is a medical reason for the individual's exemption from being fully vaccinated against COVID-19; and
  - Provide any effective time period for the medical reason that must include the date the patron is seeking access to the facility.
