We will be holding a 12-team B Division (for teams B and CC) and a 12-team C Division (for teams C and under). The winners of each Division will be invited to the North American Finals in Jan. 2013. We will also be using the Blyth Community Centre on the Saturday of our tournament.

PERIODS: 10-10-15 stop time

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Championship, Consolation

ENTRY DEADLINE: The first 12 teams in B division and the first 12 teams in C division will be accepted. Each player receives a Silver Stick pin and a meal. Special awards will be presented: banners and pins to the winners.

Application is not complete unless accompanied by your entry fee and team roster.

## Rules and Information

1. Each team in the tournament is guaranteed 3 games.
2. Each team will receive a meal after their first game.
3. All teams receive Silver Stick participation pins.
4. The tournament is sanctioned by the International Silver Stick Hockey Association and the OMHA.
5. Tournament acceptance will be confirmed 3 weeks prior to the tournament.
6. Equipment cannot be stored in the arena.
7. All teams must bring two sets of sweaters.
8. Each team will be allowed a 3 minute warm up prior to the start of the game.
9. Tie Breaking Procedure for round Robin Play:
  - (a) The team will play in the round robin series, with two points for a win and one point for a tie.
  - (b) In the event of a tie at the conclusion of regular scheduled series, the following will prevail:
    - i) If still tied, the winner of the game between the two tied teams will take the higher position.
    - ii) If still tied, preference will be determined by dividing the total “goals for and against” “into the goals for”. The team with the highest percentage takes the higher position.
    - iii) If still tied, the team which scored the first goal in the game between the two teams takes the higher position.
10. All teams must produce their approved player roster **1 HOUR BEFORE THE START OF THEIR GAME**, which will be checked by our registration officers. **REMEMBER – SHOULD THE TOURNAMENT BE RUNNING AHEAD OF SCHEDULE. TEAMS MUST BE AT THE ARENA ONE HOUR PRIOR TO GAME TIME AND BE PREPARED TO PLAY ½ HOUR PRIOR TO THEIR GAME TIME ON SATURDAY AND SUNDAY.**
11. Any player, coach, manager, or trainer not properly carded, will not be allowed to compete.
12. Classification must correspond to your current OMHA registration.
13. Only the first 12 teams in the B division and the first 12 teams in the C division will be accepted. **Entry deadline is Oct. 10, however, in past years the tournament has filled very quickly on a first received basis (rosters can be submitted at a later date).**
14. If a major penalty is received for fighting, the player is expelled from the tournament.

**NOTE: International Silver Stick has designated specific areas for Regional Tournaments to obtain teams from for their tournaments. Regional Tournaments must accept teams from their area first to fill their tournaments. You must apply to the Regional Tournament in your area if you wish to go to a Silver Stick Tournament. If you are not accepted into the Regional Tournament in your area, you may apply to other Silver Stick Regionals providing proof that you applied to the Regional in your area.**

Games will be played in the North Huron Westcast Community Complex located in Wingham. There is an NHL size ice surface and six large dressing rooms, a first aid room, fitness club, swimming pool, squash courts and a hall. We will also be playing games in the Blyth Arena on Saturday. The Blyth arena has just been newly renovated with an expanded ice surface and new dressing rooms. Our facilities should guarantee a great time for everyone.
