



Officials Code of Conduct

As an Official participating in the Blyth Brussels Minor Hockey Association, I agree to adopt the following Code of Conduct. I fully understand that breaching this Code could result in a suspension of duties for the remainder of the season.

- Respect and adhere to all ideals, policies and rules determined by OWH, OMHA, WOAA, Hockey Canada and Blyth Brussels Minor Hockey Association.
- I will make sure that every player has a reasonable opportunity to perform to the best of his or her ability, within the limits of the rules.
- I will avoid or put an end to any situation that threatens the safety of the players.
- Treat everyone fairly regardless of gender, ability, religion, race, ethnic background or economic status.
- I will not permit the intimidation of any player either by word or by action. I will not tolerate unacceptable conduct toward officials, other players, spectators or myself.
- I will be consistent and objective in calling all infractions, regardless of my personal feelings toward a team or individual players.
- I will handle all conflicts firmly but with dignity.
- I accept my role as a teacher and role model for fair play, especially with young participants.
- I will be open to discussion and contact with the players before and after the game.
- I will remain open to constructive criticism and show respect and consideration for different points of view.
- I will obtain proper training and continue to upgrade my officiating skills.
- I will work in cooperation with coaches for the benefit of the game.
